⁷ Then he said to him, “I AM THE LORD who brought you out...”

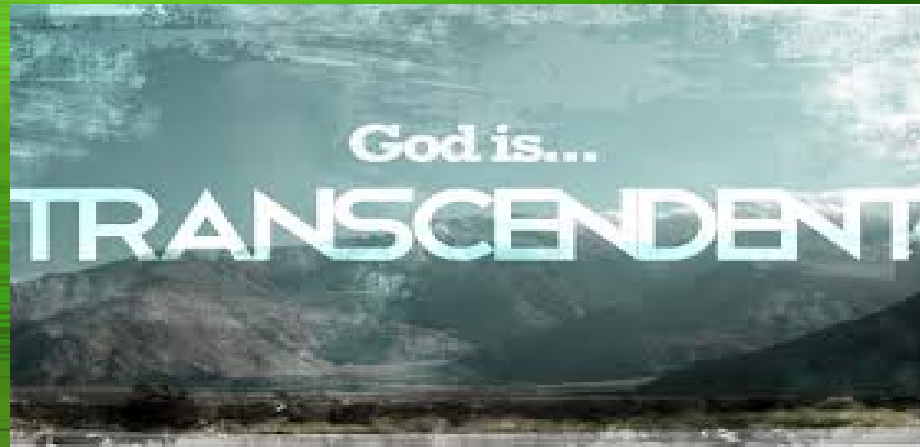
ISAIAH 55:8-9
