DOCTRINĂ SĂNĂTOASĂ

- Doctrine in the great commission: “make disciples...teaching them...” (Matt. 28:19-20)
- Doctrine = Teaching
- Two reasons we should care about doctrine
 - Doctrine is *vital*
 - Doctrine is *practical*

Vital for the integrity and the identity of the church

➤ False teachers distort the truth

And men will rise up from your own number with deviant doctrines to lure the disciples into following them. (HCSB)

Distort the truth (NIV)

Speaking twisted things (ESV)

Speaking perverse things (NASB)


Teaching perversions of the truth (NET)
